Chairman Harry Bell called the meeting to order. Mr. Jerry Mayes made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 11th meeting, seconded by Mr. Henry Bolding, approved 4-0.

No citizen comments.

No staff comments.

Old business. Ms. Lindsay Deter-Wolf represented Big Shakes Nashville Hot Chicken located at 720 Rivergate Parkway, Suite B. Ms. Deter-Wolf explained the outstanding items were the door and the seating chart. She stated the door came in yesterday, the owner was meeting with the contractor today and the door was being installed tomorrow. Mr. Larry DiOrio stated he needed an updated seating chart and to check for egress. The board questioned if a permit had been pulled yet for the construction of the door. Mr. DiOrio stated he'd not been contacted yet. Ms. Deter-Wolf is not a part of the construction process but guessed that the contractor would pull a permit before starting construction. City Manager Tim Ellis questioned if the owner was in town today and if so, why wasn't he at the meeting? Ms. Deter-Wolf stated the owner would be at the store later this morning to meet with the contractor. She explained the owner wasn't there because she was the one handling the beer permit application since the start of the process. Mr. Ellis recommended the Beer Board deny the current application due to spiraling details that keep changing. Mr. Ellis recommended the board waive the application fee should the applicant reapply with updated information within a 35-day period. If the applicant hasn't reapplied by next month the application fee will be reinstated. Mr. Mayes made a motion to following the guidelines of the City Manager. Seconded by Mr. Bolding the board voted 4-0 to deny the current application.

New business. General Manager, Jackie Lazenby, represented Fun Eats and Drinks DBA: Bailey's Sports Grill located at 786 Rivergate Parkway, Suite 12. Requesting a special event permit, Ms. Lazenby stated Bailey's Block Party would incorporate the surrounding strip mall businesses, making it a community event. This event is a free event to the community and family friendly. The only thing being sold outside are 16 oz aluminum cans of beer. All alcohol served outside will be consumed outside. All alcohol served inside will be consumed inside. They plan to operate almost as two separate entities during the event. The establishment would remain 21 and up. Chief Goodwin didn't

foresee any parking issues with this event. Bailey's obtained signatures from each surrounding store that they were aware of the event and they could speak in opposition of the event at the beer board meeting. No one was there to speak in opposition. Chief Goodwin referenced the application stating Bailey's would hire 2-3 security guards and that he didn't have any issues with the application as it was being proposed. City Manager Ellis asked Ms. Lazenby if they had spoken with NBT at all, seeing as how they may get overflow parking. She hadn't but understood the reasoning. They plan to use plastic orange construction fencing to barricade the area. They are aware of the State regulations for hiring security guards. Mr. Bolding made a motion to approve the special event permit for Fun Eats and Drinks DBA: Bailey's Sports Grill. Seconded by Mr. Sloan the board voted 4-0 approving the special event permit

Mr. Mayes made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Bolding the board voted 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:19.
