Household Hazardous Waste



Hazardous waste products include acids, paints, poisons, and solvents.

Tips to help reduce the necessity to dispose of these materials:

- Buy only what you need
- Use and reuse as much as possible
- Allow liquid wastes to dry
- Use according to manufacturer's instruction.
- Dispose of properly at local collection facilities.
- Recycle used oil



NEVER...

- Dispose of hazardous wastes down the drain, storm drain, the ground, or into the sanitary sewer system
- Dump hazardous wastes on the ground
- Burn hazardous wastes
- Bury containers

HAZARDOUS WASTES...

- Acids and Caustics
- Aerosols
- Antifreeze
- Bleach
- Cleaners and Polishes
- Disinfectants
- Gasoline
- Insecticides, Herbicides, and Pesticides
- Medicines
- Paint
- Solvent



Make sure the product meets your needs by reading the label before purchasing.

- Buy only what is needed.
- Read and follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully.
- Use products in their recommended concentration.
- Know which products are toxic and store accordingly.
- Keep substances out of the reach of children and animals.
- Use child-resistant caps.
- Replace caps and coverings after each use.
- Contact the manufacturer if you have any questions or concerns about the usage and storage of the product.
- Do not mix chemicals together.
- Do not store chemicals with food items.
- Flammables should not be stored with corrosives.
- Do not store chemicals in food containers.
